

Winter is coming



Our team responded quickly and immediately called Klaserie HQ who informed the local vet. The vet arrived shortly after the call with his very professional team and stitched her wounds together.

A big thank you to Dr. Rodgers & team for their amazing work saving this big cat's life and for answering all of our questions!

Despite the fact that it was an incredible experience, we hope to not see this kind of injury - caused by human beings - ever again!

Wildlife Update
