


MOTHER'S DAY IN THE HEART OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN BUSHVELD!

Welcome to this month's Wildlife Report!

Leopard:

Leopard sightings have been really good, not as frequent but nice long static sightings which give us great quality time with them.

Lion:

Lion sightings have been interesting, we have seen a small breakaway group from the large river pride, about 5 individuals of which one is a female with 3 new cubs, roughly about 10-12 weeks old.

Elephant:

We had some wonderful elephant sightings throughout the traverse, especially around the windmill pan and Malembeni watering hole - there are so many babies around at the moment!

Buffalo:

Buffalo herds have been scarce, only the dagga boys have been around, but they have given us some really good sightings.

Hyena:

Still every report on Hyenas has been positive, they are still the apex predator in our area and they basically rule the Malembeni area. There are a few pups around and they all range from +/- 6 weeks to 7 months. They are super sweet!

Highlight of the month by Ruan:

While having coffee, before game drive one morning, I saw something walking from the Nyala berry tree in front of the lodge and realised it is a male lion. I quickly ran to call the guests to show them the lion when...

Travel Updates

COUNTRY TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

As stated by South African President Cyril Ramaphosa, a negative PCR test will no longer be required for international travelers who are fully vaccinated. This means that travelers are now required to only show a "valid vaccination certificate" upon entry into the country. Unvaccinated travelers can continue to enter the country after presenting a negative PCR test.

South Africa is currently on "Alert Level 1", which is the lowest level in the country, finally making traveling around the country a smooth and easy process so you can enjoy your stay!

With these requirements in place, Makumu Private Game Lodge still uses 'COVID Best Practice Guidelines' for safety measures to protect our guests at all costs.
