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## Food for the Soul

We picked our top 3 favourite Makumu dishes:

Our **fish curry** is a favourite at Makumu, with repeat guests often requesting this delicious meal. We use kingklip, one of the most popular eating fish in South Africa, along with fresh local ingredients and jasmine rice. The name kingklip comes from the old Dutch word "koningklipvisch", meaning "king of the rock fishes" – because like other whitefish (such as hake), kingklip is low in fat and prized for its delicate flavour and firm white flesh.

A specialty at Makumu is our **flat egg**, a creation by owner Stefan Breuer. A delicious and different way to experience breakfast, pick your fillings and enjoy!

They always say you never eat better than when on safari, and that couldn't be more true at Makumu. Our lovely ladies really know what they are doing when it comes to meal times and our **three cheese parcel** is always a hit!



Some other favourites include our **homemade chilli**, **muesli and yoghurt cup** **with a fresh fruit kebab** and of course, our **grenadine and lemonade** welcome drink!

A word of caution: take it easy on the chilli and make a note of which you will like (or be able to handle!). These chillis are homemade; the green being mild, red being hot and yellow for the experienced chilli eaters!



## Conservation Celebration

In the month of August there were three special conservation-related days; World Elephant Day, World Lion Day and National Honeybee Day. We are proud to say all three of these are found in the Klaserie Private Nature Reserve.

Many may be more impressed by the lion and the elephant but not many know

that honeybees are crucial in the survival of the environment. They are the world's most important pollination of food crops. It is estimated that one third of the food that we consume each day relies on pollination mainly by bees!

During this period with no guests, we are still looking after the wellbeing of our lodge by tending to gardens, doing maintenance and cleaning. It was on one of these routine checks on the morning of the 14<sup>th</sup> of July that Ruan, our Assistant Manager and Morné, our General Manager noticed something odd on the patch of gravel in front of the Ranger's storeroom. Upon closer inspection they found



that it was bits of rumen (stomach content) from an antelope. They thought a Hyena may have been the culprit as the local clan members around the lodge often kill impalas close to the camp.

They proceeded to the lodge gardens to open the sprinklers and headed back up to the office, not thinking much about the little bit of evidence that was left for them.

Later that afternoon, Ruan mentioned that he was going to turn the sprinkler system off. No sooner had he left, Ruan called the team on the radio to tell them about a furry guest at our Ndebele Villa's pathway! The team quickly grabbed cameras and jumped in a game viewer to meet Ruan to see Makumu's first guest in months - a beautiful male leopard!

As they drove into the turning circle, they could see the remains of an impala carcass hanging in a tree (which was not there earlier) close to the Ndebele Villa. They positioned the vehicle in the turning circle close to the tree and had a careful look in the long grass under the walkway to see where the guest was hiding. The flick of a tail gave his hiding spot away and he was found resting in the shade of the walkway.

After a few minutes he stood up, wandered across the lawn, jumped into the tree and carried on with business as usual, as if it is the most natural thing to have his food in a camp!

Our team was so excited to have such a spectacular sighting right on our doorstep!
