

New Levies Introduced in the Klaserie

The Klaserie Private Nature Reserve has recently introduced new levies to guests entering the area applicable from 1st September 2018.

We apologise for the short notice, which is beyond our control, however this is a very necessary measure for conservation purposes. We kindly ask that our trade partners update their clients: for existing bookings, the levies can be settled directly on departure at Makumu. For any future bookings, these will be added to invoices.

Conservation Levy

R115 per person per night, ages 12+

This levy will be used to subsidise anti-poaching efforts to ensure constant improvement of counter poaching technology, further develop smart fences, pay additional teams, contribute to the cost of all counter poaching flights and

purchasing of new equipment to ensure the continual protection of vulnerable species within the reserve.

Bed Levy

R250 per person per stay, once-off

This contribution ensures that the reserve remains in pristine condition and goes a long way to ensuring the reduction of the camp's carbon footprint as there is a strict protocol in place to ensure that all camps have a minimal impact on the environment. The levy also helps with the maintenance of roads, clearing of invasive plants, fire break management and other aspects that contribute to the overall health of the reserve.
