All at Makumu are overjoyed with the recent discovery of two 6-month old leopard cubs on the concession. Since the first surprise encounter, the cubs (sexes unknown) have been seen regularly along the Melembeni and Xidulu riverbeds, secluded and hidden in the thick and tangled vegetation.

With numerous impala in the area, these are ideal hunting grounds for mom as she expertly provides meals, hoisting kills in trees and out of reach of hyena and lion.

The cubs are flourishing and growing fast, and although never far from mom, are becoming more adventurous and independent with every encounter.
