

It's *SUMMER* at Makumu Private Game Lodge and Game Drives have been spectacular! We have had exceptional sightings very close to the lodge and throughout our traverse...

<u>Elephant:</u> Now that there's been rain, there are several mud pools around, and as most of us know, elephants love spending time at the "spa" getting themselves all muddy to help cool themselves down and to help with exfoliation. We were lucky enough to spot this!

<u>Lion:</u> We have had incredible lion sightings over the last month and very close to the lodge. They have also been spending time along the river system hunting buffalo in the river system and giraffe on the embankments. They have also been spending time in the Dundee Creek that runs past the front end of the lodge.

**<u>Buffalo:</u>** Buffalo herds have been coming and going in large numbers, over 200 in the one group and then a large group of old boys, up to 20 males. It's great to see them again as we usually only see them in winter months with the water shortages.

<u>Wilddog:</u> Probably our highlight of the month, we had them at morning coffee stops and around the lodge for two days!
